Activities of the Training Unit in 2003

In addition to organizing seminars and conferences, whose detailed description can be found later in the text, the staff of the Training Unit was involved in a number of other activities aimed at securing long-term cooperation in the field of capacity building of civil servants with our partners from abroad and in the country.

Human Resources Management

Negotiations with partners and preparations for a project that will concentrate on creating necessary prerequisites for establishment of an efficient human resource management in cooperation with the E-Net center have been successfully completed. We are currently working on identification of 12 senior managers who will actively participate in the project that is expected to start early next year.

The project will have a strategic approach to human resource management and will focus on creating effective policies in the HRM in institutions of BiH. This approach will not be a traditional one and it is planned as a problem solving endeavour in which the participants will identify the problems and priorities and lead the process of learning themselves. Coaching will be provided by experts from the University of Alberta, Canada through use of video conferencing and by local experts from the Faculty of Economics. The project is expected to last for 9 months with the end result being design of projects that would help solve the identified problems.

Training Needs Assessment

In an effort to upgrade the existing database of training needs and areas for capacity building, we have distributed a questionnaire to all institutions in November / December. The information we have collected is currently being analyzed and will serve as a starting point for future trainings.

Implementation of Tempus Project "Training and Capacity Building for the Civil Service and Public Administration Personnel in BiH"

Civil Service Agency is a partner in the project that has a main objective to assess the training needs of Civil Servants in Public Administration, provide training capacity and skills required, and support and reinforce the role of Civil Service in BiH state and entity administration. The project will last for three years and was started in November.

Submission of Tempus Project Proposal: Mobile Administrative Academy for Southeast Europe

Objectives of the project are development of uniform model curriculum for training of civil servants, establishment of training centers and libraries, conduct of training modules. If approved, implementation of the project will start next year.

Cooperation with partners abroad

We have defined areas for training in 2004 with the **Embassy of France** – Department for Cultural and Scientific Cooperation, as well as with the **Embassy of Spain** – Technical Office of Cooperation with the Balkans. As in 2003, the lectures, adjusted to specific needs of BiH civil servants, will be delivered by experts coming from these two countries.

A twinning project between the Ministry of Finance and Treasury and a similar ministry in Austria is currently being prepared. The project will be realized in the second half of 2004 in cooperation with the **Finanzakademie** in Austria.

Successful cooperation with **InWEnt** in 2003 is expected to be broadened in 2004 in accordance with conclusions of the conference organized on December 16.

Contacts were established with the **Political Academy** from Austria and **Multilateral Academy** from Germany related to possible cooperation in the field of training of civil servants.

Embassy of Poland in BiH organized a visit for the Director of the Civil Service Agency, Mr. Jakob Finci, to the Polish Civil Service Agency in November for exchange of views on best practices.
